TEST LIMITS

Each event (test) is limited to 125 entries.

THE COURSE WILL BE FENCED.

Tests will be run concurrently both days.

Fast CAT Test (FCAT)

Fast CAT is an outdoor pass/fail test that consists of a 100-yard dash using a straight course or track. Dogs run singly and are required to reach the finish line. The dog's time to complete the course is converted into MPH and then to points based on height by using a handicap. The system is based on the dog's height at its withers:

18" or greater = handicap is 1.0

12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5

Below 12" = handicap is 2.0

Timing will be done electronically, using break the beam equipment. The dog's time to complete the course is recorded to the nearest 1/100th of a second. (Example: 9.11 seconds)

Conversion of time to MPH is rounded to the nearest hundredth of a mile:
 $204.545/\text{dog's time} = \text{MPH}$

Points are earned by the dog's MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap.

A dog that relieves itself on course shall fail the test. Handlers may not travel down the 100 yard course with the dog or just prior to the dog being released for its run; this includes inside and outside the fence. Handlers may not run with the dog in the starting box. Handlers may run within the catch area as their dog is running the course but may not cross the finish line. Handlers must remain at either the start or the end of the course. Cheering, clapping, calling your dog's name, whistling, and waving your arms from the end of the course or the start area is allowed. Noise making devices such as whistles, duck calls, electronic calls or other items of this nature are not permitted. The use of toys, treats, flags or other items of this nature are not permitted while the dog is running the 100-yard course, however they may be used after the dog has crossed the finish line to assist in catching the dog. Dogs must be caught at the completion of the course and cannot be recalled by their handler at the start line. Should a situation arise where the application of this Regulation is open for interpretation, the event committee shall decide how it will be handled.

It is safest for dogs to run "naked" which means they do not wear a collar. However, dogs may wear any collar except a choker collar, a collar with prongs, or an electronic training collar. The collar should be snug to minimize the chances of getting hung up on something during the run. Owners should be aware that there is a chance that tags hanging from the collar could become entangled on something during the run. *The test committee may, at its discretion, require hanging collar tags to be secured to the collar with tape or in some other manner.* Owners may use clips or rubber bands to hold the dog's hair. The owner assumes responsibility for

the safety of the dog regarding the dog's collar and paraphernalia on the dog.

ENTRY FEES

Entry postmarked/handed to Test Secretary on or prior to 9/6: \$25 per dog per event (test).

Gate Entry: \$30 per dog per event (test).

Junior Handler*: \$20 per dog per event (test).

** A Junior is defined as anyone younger than 18 years of age. The Junior must handle/release the dog in the CAT or handle/release or catch the dog in the FCAT to qualify for the reduced entry fee. Juniors should apply for and receive an AKC Junior Handler Number prior to test day. Junior Handler Certification forms will be available from the Test Secretary. If the dog is entered under this provision but the Junior does not handle/release or catch the dog, the owner must pay the regular entry fee as published in the premium. *FCAT Note – Juniors can catch their dog instead of release, but they must be able to catch, leash, and leave the catch area with their dog on their own safely.*

Refund Policy: Dogs determined to be lame or unfit to participate by the Inspection Committee, owner or agent at the time of roll call or upon previous notification by the owner or agent shall be barred from participating and their entry fees shall be refunded in full. Bitches in season may not participate, or bitches which come in season after the close of entries, shall be barred from participating in the test and their entry fees shall be refunded in full. Notification to the Secretary of bitches in season must be made before or during the roll call. A note from a veterinarian is not required. Bitches known to be in season shall not be brought onto the test grounds. *No shows are not entitled to refund of entry fee(s). Entry pulled after the test(s) have filled are not entitled to refund of entry fee(s).

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. A fee of \$40.00 will be assessed for any returned checks.
2. Incomplete, unsigned, conditional, or unpaid entries will not be accepted. **Entries received prior to the following will not be accepted:**
 - a. **Ibizan Hounds: Wed, Aug 2nd, 8AM**
 - b. **Otterhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Black Russian Terriers, Canaan Dogs: Wed, Aug 9th, 8AM**
 - c. **All Breeds: Wed, Aug 16th, 8AM**
3. **Dogs will be assigned a one hour time slot. If you enter both tests (AM and PM) on a single day BOTH of your runs will occur during your assigned time slot.** Please indicate what your preferred time slots are on your entry form. If a preference isn't noted, you'll be assigned a time slot based on order of entry received. Every effort will be made to meet your preference; your flexibility is appreciated. Multiple dog households will have dogs separated but can be in the same group.
 - a. We will work with you if you have a ring conflict that weekend. Please keep in contact with the Test Secretary if you anticipate missing your time slot. On the day of the events, text will be the quickest way to reach the Test Secretary; her phone number is 515.231.8980.
4. Entries must be received by the Test Secretary by the entry deadline listed on the front cover of this premium list.
5. The Club and/or Test Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry form.
6. **Dogs must be ready to run. Catchers must be ready for their dog and in the catch pen when their dog has moved to the start box. Club need not wait for dogs or catchers that hold up the test.**
7. The Club and/or the Test Secretary assume no responsibility for injury or a dog's failure to recall.
8. At the discretion of the Test Chairman, there may be a \$5.00 fine assessed for any loose dog on the field not taking part in the course in progress.
9. Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds by the field committee. Children must be under the control of their parent(s) or guardian at all times.
10. Only the lure operator, huntmaster, handlers of the course in progress will be permitted near the lure operating equipment.
11. No substitution of entries if the test(s) fill prior to the pre-entry deadline.

ROLL CALL & INSPECTION

Inspection begins 15 minutes prior to the start of your assigned time slot. There are 4 morning time slots – 8, 9, 10, and 11AM; and 4 afternoon time slots – 1, 2, 3, and 4PM.

** Early acceptance of dogs for members of the field committee may begin one-half hour prior to published test hours. The club will take a lunch break between morning and afternoon sessions.*

Being inspected satisfies roll call. Dogs not present at the time of inspection will be scratched. Please provide your dog's handicap with your entries. If you aren't sure how tall your dog is at the withers, we will measure your dog at inspection and assign a handicap.

Each entry will be inspected for lameness, fitness to participate and females in season. Inspection shall take place prior to any form of wrapping being applied to the dog. In the opinion of the inspection committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit to participate or a female in season shall not be allowed to enter and entry fees shall be refunded in full; females in season shall be removed from the test site.

Dogs that are physically challenged due to loss of limbs are eligible to enter and should be given the same consideration by the inspection committee as four-legged dogs. A dog that exhibits a state of well-being at the time of inspection, shows no signs of physical discomfort, and in the opinion of the inspection committee appears to physically have the potential to safely complete the course, is to be considered fit to participate.

PRE-COURSE BRIEFING

Pre-course briefings and final time slot assignments will be emailed to all participants by 9/12. Club members will be on site to help answer any in person questions that arise.

ELIGIBILITY

FCATs are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are registered/enrolled with the AKC in one of the following ways:

- individually registered with the AKC
- recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program
- individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration
- dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number
 - Information on getting your dog a PAL number can be found here: www.akc.org/register/dog/
- dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration
- mixed breed dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners (CP) program.
 - Information about obtaining a CP number can be found here: www.akc.org/register/dog/
- Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate.

- Bitches in season may not enter.
- Dogs that are physically challenged due to loss of limbs are eligible to enter and should be given the same consideration by the inspection committee as four-legged dogs.
 - For safety purposes, any dog requiring an assistance apparatus, such as a wheeled cart will not be allowed to participate.
- A dog may enter only once per event (test).

AWARDS

Each dog that passes the test will receive a ribbon that is light blue in color.

Each dog that earns a new BCAT will receive a new BCAT rosette.

Each dog that earns a new DCAT will receive a new DCAT rosette.

Each dog that earns a new FCAT will receive a new FCAT rosette.*

** Please let the Test Secretary know if your dog could possibly earn a new title at our event so we have enough rosettes on hand.*

TITLES

Dogs can earn three titles by accumulating points. These are suffix titles that will appear on a dog's pedigree with a higher level title superseding a lower level title.

- BCAT – Awarded to a dog that accumulates 150 points.
- DCAT – Awarded to a dog that accumulates 500 points.
- FCAT – Awarded to a dog that accumulates 1,000 points. For every 500 points over 1,000, the dog earns FCAT followed by a number (ex: FCAT2, FCAT3, etc)

TIPS FOR HANDLERS

1. Please familiarize yourself with the rules and regulations for FastCAT events. Regulations can be found here: [AKC1812-REFCAT.pdf](#)
2. Bring at least 2 collars and/or leashes.
3. You may either release your dog or catch your dog. Please plan on finding or bringing someone with you to help.
4. Handlers should wear comfortable, sturdy shoes (no sandals or flip flops) and be physically able to hold and release their dogs, as well as catch them.
5. Dogs will be brought to the start line on leash and released only upon a verbal signal ("Tally-Ho!") from the Huntmaster. Dogs may be released by hand, folded leash, or traditional lure coursing lead.
6. The Huntmaster will instruct the handler to "Retrieve your dog" upon completion of the run. The handler is expected to promptly secure the dog and leave the field with the dog on leash.
7. Handlers are advised to warm up their dogs prior to their run and walk them for 10 minutes afterwards.
8. Coursing is a physically demanding sport and can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are old, have breathing or heart problems, are overweight, or are out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. Consult your veterinarian if you have concerns.
9. Muzzles are not required but are permitted at the handler's discretion.

COURSE PLAN

- The lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips.
- Gas or battery powered equipment in a continuous loop will be used. Back up equipment is the same.
- The field committee reserves the right to alter the course depending on the field and other conditions.
- The field will be fenced using construction debris safety fencing. The landscape is natural, mowed grass. The run out will be 35+ yards long.

FACILITIES

Restrooms are on site. Please plan on bringing what you need to keep yourself and dog comfortable – water, shade, fans. **Please plan on picking up after yourself and your dog.**
