## "KLEE KAI" NEWEST OF RARE BREEDS

### THE LEGEND:

*Somewhere within the Great Land called Alaska, between the massive mountains, the vast oceans, the silent tundra and the endless sheets of ice, the Glacier Witch looked down and smiled at the bright eyed, tiny form in front of her. After rescuing it from the icy waters and drying it before the fire, it appeared somewhat smaller than before, and she was pleased. All others must be spayed or neutered, this is done in an effort to keep this breed a QUALITY breed and to keep serious faults or medical problems from developing.

The Klee Kai have two categories, breeding quality and pet quality. These rules will be strictly enforced to keep any faults out of the line. Klee Kai must have a prominent mask, all markings must be symmetrical. Toys weigh up to 12 pounds, miniatures weigh from 12 to 20 pounds. There is an oversize category for females from 20 to 25 pounds. "Halea" is the smallest adult female Klee Kai in existence, she only weighs 3 pounds!
